## WINTER PRODUCT PORTFOLIO 2017/18



### Cottages: Reindeer Lodge

One of-a-kind and cosy cottage accommodation in Sámi design amidst the winter wonderland of Swedish Lapland. Remotely situated in the woods, our reindeer roam on the premise on the guests' doorstep. Enjoy delicious dinners from local produce served by the host; and relax in our wood-burning sauna and watch the dazzling northern light illuminating the night sky. Snowshoes and cross-country skis are available; and the world-famous Icehotel located in only half an hour's walking distance. **Included:** 2-course dinner at 18.00 and breakfast buffet 08.00-10.00. Sauna, sleeping bag, bed linen and bathing towel. Reindeer feeding at 10.00. Free entry to Sámi Siida-Márkanbáiki. Scheduled check-in/out transfer.

**Check-in transfers:** 14.30 from tourist center in Kiruna & 15.30 from Icehotel.

**Check-out transfer:** 11.00 from Reindeer Lodge via Icehotel, Kiruna Airport and train station to central Kiruna.

**Price:** SEK 1650 per adult per night in double/triple and four bed room.

SEK 960 per child (3-12 years) per night in double/triple and four bed room together with adult/s.

**Information:** Five wooden double bed cottages, each cottage is one large room á 20 m<sup>2</sup>. Four out of five cottages are also furnished with a sofa bed (size 1.60 x 1.80 m). Each cottage is equipped with wood-fired stove and electrical heater, table and chairs. A joint wood-fired sauna with single-sex shower and dressing compartments as well as WCs are found in separate communal facilities. A common timber log building serves as kitchen/dining room with seating and free Wi-Fi.

**Address:** Paksuniemivägen 188 in SE-981 91 Jukkasjärvi, which is 3 km from Icehotel/Jukkasjärvi village, 15 km from Kiruna Airport and 20 km from central Kiruna.

### Day trip: Ráidu – Encounter with reindeer

Join a Sámi reindeer herder to meet and feed Nils Torbjörn Nutti's reindeer herd outside Jukkasjärvi. Avail yourself of the opportunity to lasso a reindeer and to have a short reindeer sled drive. These are skills connected to traditional indigenous Sámi knowledge which we practice, try to preserve and share with people keen on testing in the field. We keep and fodder part of our reindeer herd during winter to help them survive hard grazing conditions due to climate change; and you assist us to feed them. There are adult reindeer and from around mid-December also calves. The Sámi signature dish suovas will be prepared over open flames and eaten in a lávvu-tent with a hot drink around the fireside.

### Day trip: Eallin – Nature and wildlife photo tour

Join a local guide on tour in beautiful nature in a diverse landscape. You will be provided with photo equipment and introduced in its use so that you are able to capture images of views in magic light conditions. We are flexible with our minibus and look also out for animals, for example moose or ptarmigan, roaming seasonally caused in our surroundings. The guide shares stories about animals and nature, our Sámi culture, heritage and arctic lifestyle.

Hot drink and cake incl. Loan of camera with 300mm telephoto lens and tripod incl. Personal SD-card with minimum 8 GB memory req. Min age 10 years.

### Night trip: Guovssahas – Northern light photo tour

Join a local guide on a hunt to savour the sight of the northern lights adorning the night sky with their mysterious and ever changing veils. Provided with photo equipment and after an introduction in its use we choose a location with our minibus where we have the greatest chance for clear night sky which is a prerequisite for seeing the northern light. We capture images of the aurora borealis, ourselves and the surroundings with camera. The guide shares Sámi stories connected to the light and our arctic lifestyle. Hot drink incl. Loan of camera with wide-angle-lens, tripod and torch included. Personal SD-card with minimum 8 GB memory required. Min age 10 years.

Enjoy a reindeer ride, dog sledding, skiing and get pampered with culinary delights from the Sámi cuisine. 1 night's accommodation at Reindeer Lodge, 6 nights at Árrenjarka Mountain Lodge. Board spec. Min age 12 years. Start and end in Kiruna.

## Day visit: Sámi Siida - Márkanbáiki

Sámi Siida is an easily accessible, vibrant meeting place in Jukkasjärvi for visitors from near and far who want to engage their senses to experience Sápmi. Grazing reindeer at the banks of mighty River Torne, outdoor exhibitions covering nomadic and modern Sámi life, camp fires, local Sámi slow food in Café Sápmi, and arts and crafts. All this and more is found on the old Sámi market and assembly place that is origin for the village of Jukkasjärvi.

Ideal for day visitors with a limited amount of time, but still an interest to get an introduction to Sámi culture, food and reindeer.

**Daily:** 10.00 - 17.00. 6 Nov 2017 - 8 April 2018, 24 Dec open until 13.00.

**Admission fee:** SEK 160 per person, SEK 130 per student, SEK 80 per child (3-15 years), free for children under 3 years.

**Guided tours:** 10.00 & 16.00 Exclusive reindeer feeding tour and area visit with a guide. Tour duration: approx. 45 min.

**Tour price:** SEK 100 per person, SEK 50 per child (3-15 years), free for children under 3 years. Guided tours only purchasable in combination with entrance ticket.

Nutti Sámi Siida in Jukkasjärvi, Swedish Lapland, is a renowned Sámi ecotourism company that features the indigenous Sámi culture and nature in a responsible and sustainable way by offering exceptional cottage accommodation at Reindeer Lodge with reindeer as the natural residents on-site, and different winter activities both day and night time. The tours vary from reindeer sledding to wildlife and northern light watching with photography touch; and they are all good to combine with a multiple nights stay at Reindeer Lodge for different tour package solutions. Sámi Siida-Márkanbáiki is an ideal attraction for day visitors. Nutti Sámi Siida is located approx. 15 km from Kiruna Airport (KRN). There are daily flight (ARN) and train (Stockholm Central Station) connections from/to Stockholm. Quality labelled according to Nature's Best by the Swedish Ecotourism Society, and to Sápmi Experience by VisitSápmi.

## General product information:

**Equipment:** Loan of winter outer wear, i.e. thermal overall, warm boots, mittens and hat, is included in all our tours except for photography tours where loan of warm boots, windproof pants and cape, and also photo equipment is included. Helmet is included in the Ráidu. Jokkmokk journey requires personal winter outer wear.

**Diet:** Special dietary requirements (e.g. vegetarianism, pescetarianism, allergies, etc.) have to be advised at booking.

**Number of participants:** The minimum number of participants for tours is depending on the tour one or two people.

**Transfers:** Use of scheduled transfer options for Reindeer Lodge stay have to be advised at booking, no extra charge.

**Transfers from/to Reindeer Lodge and hotel/tourist center in Kiruna respectively for tours are included in tour times.**

**Excluded:** Travel insurance, international and domestic fare, and alcoholic beverages are not included in the rates.

**Conditions:** Product sheets give detailed information. Guests participate in our activities at their own responsibility and are obliged to follow the safety instructions assigned by the guide. All tours will be adapted to prevailing weather conditions. Although the chance of seeing the northern light is quite high, a sighting cannot be guaranteed due to it being a natural phenomenon. The same applies to free roaming wildlife.
