Sámi Siida - Márkanbáiki

Discover Sápmi in our easily accessible exhibition area where you can meet and feed our reindeer or try traditional Sámi food in Café Sápmi. As a reminder of your visit you surely find some special item in our on-site handicraft shop!



The term Márkanbáiki means meeting or market place in North Sámi language. This site is the origin of the village of Jukkasjärvi and has a rich history we want to share with you.

In our exhibition you can learn about the culture, traditions, nomadic lifestyle and the history of the reindeer herding Sámi. Our most appreciated companions, the reindeer, are a part of the exhibition and you can feed them on your own with their favourite food, reindeer lichen.

The guided tour is a perfect opportunity to get a more personal understanding about our culture. Our knowledgeable guides will walk you around the exhibition while they share their own personal stories as well as facts and answer questions. In the end will you also follow the guide to the reindeer corral to say hi and give them some candy, a perfect opportunity to get close and take pictures!



In Café Sápmi we offer local delicacies and traditional Sámi meals with a modern twist. Coffee cheese, pastries and of course reindeer meat are some of our specialties. Everything we serve is carefully chosen from local producers with nature and environment in mind. The meals are cooked over the fire in the middle of our lávvu-like restaurant.

As a reminder of your stay you can visit our gift and handicraft shop to find the most unique gifts. We offer only the best of our local Sámi handicraft, duodji. Among the crafts you find reindeer pelts and antler designs, Sámi silver jewellery and even lassos for catching reindeer.

We also offer private guiding and group events on request.

ADMISSION FEE: Adult: SEK 200, Student (with valid ID): SEK 160, Child (3-12 yrs): SEK 100.
No admission fee to café and handicraft shop.

GUIDED TOURS: Guided tours are included with entrance ticket and we offer them at 10.00 and 16.00. The duration of the tour is approx. 45 minutes.

ADDRESS: Marknadsvägen 2 in SE - 981 91 Jukkasjärvi. Next to Jukkasjärvi church, and 900 m from Icehotel. 15 km from Kiruna Airport and 20 km from central Kiruna. Local bus #501 and transfers by Visit Abisko.
